last Will & Testament in manner & form following.

other Estate both real & personal of any kind & condition whatsoever where-  
soever I give & bequeath unto the a<sup>r</sup> Robert Jones to him his Heirs & assigns  
forever. — And lastly I do make, nominate & constitute & appoint the above named  
Robert Jones the only Executor of this my last Will & Testament. In Testimony  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this sixth day
