I give to my son Daniel all that one thousand and fifty three acres of land where I now live to him his heirs or assigns for and during his life. I also give and bequeath to this aforesaid Daniel eight negro slaves viz: Jack, Harry, Master Dick Jaff, abraham, Jenny Latt Item I give to my son James all that three hundred and forty five acres of land which I purchased of Thomas Smith at Bull Run to him his heirs or assigns for and during his life. Item I give to my said son James nine Negro slaves viz: Mahomet Robt Will George Shillie Pegg Nan Frank & Sarah to him his heirs or assigns for and during his life. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Asberry all that parcel of Land which I have leased or intended to lease of Capt. Charles Broadwater where she now lives to her the said Martha her heirs or assigns for and during her life. Item I give to the foresaid Martha Asberry three Negro slaves viz: Doah, Moll & Tim to be absolutely under her own will power and command to her the said Martha her heirs or assigns for
