Jack, Larry, Onister Dick, Joss, Abraham, Benny, Patt Item I give to my son James all that three hundred and twenty five acres of Land which I purchased of Thomas Smith at Bull run to him his heirs or assigns for and during his life. Item I give to my said son James nine Negro slaves viz. Mahomet, Robt Will, George, Phillis, Pegg, Nan, Frank & Sarah to him his heirs or assigns for & during his life. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Asberry all that parcel of Land which I have leased or intended to lease of Capt. Charles Broadwater where she now lives to her the said Martha her heirs or assigns for and during her life. Item I give to the foresaid Martha Asberry three Negro slaves viz. Doah, Moll & Tim to be absolutely under her own will power and command to her the said Martha her heirs or assigns for &
