First I give it is my will and Desire that my two Executors hereafter named do
pay all my just debts out of my said Estate & that they do sell all that Tract of
Land which I bought of Mr. John Horsford in Prince William County & one
thousand acres of Land which I hold in Stafford County lying on Aquia river
to enable them the better to pay the same.

Now I give to my Loving wife Sarah McLarty one mulatto woman, Slave named
Mentha for and during the Term of her natural life & her future increase of
any to be disposed in the said manner as the rest of my Slaves hereafter is directed
to be divided.

Now it is my will & Desire that all the rest of my Slaves be equally Divided
between my Loving wife Sarah & five Children viz. Sons Daniel Dennis &
Theodorus & Daughters Sarah & Ann only that my Son Daniel may have the
mulatto boy David now apprentice to John Allou, joiners allotted to him in his part
& that the negro Lad Harry now also an apprentice to the said John Allou, be
allotted to my Son Daniel in his part.

Now it is my will that all the rest of my personal Estate of what nature or kind
soever be likewise equally Divided between my said wife and Children except
my plate which I give to my Son Daniel as also my wearing Apparel pistols
Holsters Holster caps Colours Swords and others troopers caparisons.

Now it is my will that notwithstanding the Devise of my Slaves as above that the

all Minors gent & deep the negro boy called Dick were
proprietors to the use of him & his heirs.

Now for appointing brother Daniel McCarty of Washington County gent &
my friend & kinsman John Minor gent & my son Daniel McCarty my
Executors of this my Last will & Testament but it is my desire that as my son
Daniel is not full age that he may not act as my Executor until he arrives
thereto unless it be upon the Death or refusal of one of my other Executors.
I do hereby ratify and confirm this to be my only last will & Testament & I do
revoke all other wills formerly by me made in which of witness I have abovementioned
