I Give to Sarah M^r Cormack one Tea Chest with Six Silver Tea Spoons and one pair of

Silver Tea Spoons - I Give all my Books and Lathen ware to be equally Divided between Sarah M^r Cormack and Amelia Watson - I Appoint my Friend George M^r Cormack my Executor to this my Last will and Testament In WITNES whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 23rd Day of Feb^r 1773
