In the name of God amen, I William Thomas of Fairfax County being sick & weak but perfect senses and memory (thanks be to God for it) do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form as followeth first I desire of God to receive my soul, and as for what worldly estate with which its bin pleased God to bless me with, I give the same as followeth. Item I give to my wife Catharine Thomas three Cows and Calves & a young heifer three young steers and all my hogs one horse and Wagon & all my household furniture, to Joseph Adams my best Coat to Ann Adams one young mare to William Adams a young horse saddle and bridle and a suit of Cloath if he lives with Catharine Thomas till he is at age and my two guns to be sold. I appoint my loving wife Catharine Thomas hole and sole Exeauter of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21. day of January 1756.
