In the name of God amen I George Johnston of Fairfax County in Virginia Attorney at Law, being sick and weak of body but of Sound mind and memory do make this my last Will & Testament in manner following (Viz³)

Imprimis My Will is that my lots in the Town of Alexandria ~~and~~ my Tract of Land at Hales Marsh in Flanders be sold by my Executors for the Payment of my just Debts.

Item I give to my wife Sarah one third part of the money arising from the Sale of the said lots and Tract of Land, and the third Part of all the rest of my Estate, for and during the Term of her Natural Life.

Item I give all the rest of my Lands to my Sons to be Equally divided amongst them and their heirs forever.

Item I Give to my Son George my Gold Watch my Gold Stock Buckle, Knee buttons and Silver Snuff box.

Item I Give and bequeath all the Remainder of my Estate ^{and wheresoever} whatsoever to be equally divided amongst all my Children both Sons and Daughters and their heirs forever except my daughter Peggy Chastin whose disobedience hath determined me thus to exclude her. Item my Will is that my Daughter Mary may receive an equal Share with the rest of my Daughters.

(103.) EXCLUDED of what I have already given her.
Item If my Wife (who is now with Child) shall be deliver
of a Son, I give him an equal share of my Estate with the
of his Brethren; and if of a Daughter I give her an equal
Portion with her Sisters.

Lastly I appoint my Wife Sarah, my Son George and
friends Daniel McCarthy and John Mayne Executors of
my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I
hereunto set my hand this 23^d day of February 1766.

George and William have lands and Slaves devised to them
by their Uncle Denis McCarthy to keep which Estate together
have paid large sums of money of which I have kept an
imperfect Account or rather none. I do therefore devise to
said George & William but half a share of my Estate.
