pose of to her Children as she thinks fit, Item it is my Will and Desier that at the Death of my
Said Wife, That my whole Estate be Equally Divided amongst my whole Children, Lastly
it is my Will and Desier that my Son Gilbert Simpson and my Wife be Executors to this my Last
