be my last Will and Testament revoking all other wills by me at any time heretofore made
In witness I render my soul to almighty God who gave it me hoping through & by the
mediation of my blessed saviour & redeemer Jesus Christ to receive pardon and
remission of my sins, and my body to be decently interred at my Executor's direction.

Item my will and desire is that my just debts be duly paid and funeral expences...

Then I will and desire that my beloved wife Sybill whom I do appoint whole and sole Executrix
of this my last will and Testament may have the use benefit and advantages of all my
estate real and personal for and during the time she remains my widow, but if she
should intermarry, then my will is that my children, or their guardians do take possession

of their several parts of my estate by me to them hereafter given and bequeathed.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son John West the plantation whereon I now
live & also the tract of land I bought of Mr. Tarrant, & the tract I bought of Mr. Weston
adjoining thereto, And the tract of land lying on Dogue Run and Piney run (which
I had by his mother) to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son Hugh West that tract of land I bought of
John Howell lying near wolf Trap run, to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son George West the tract of land I bought
of Hollifield near Goose Creek, and the tract of land I bought of Noland above Pine
Creek to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son William West the tracts of land I
bought of Connell & Lynch joining on Simpson and my tract of land at the Caledon
Mountains, to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Sybil West the land I bought of
Farmer, the lots in Alexandria Town where my Ordinary and Warehouses now are &
the benefit of the Ferry, to her and her heirs forever. Also the remaining part of
the land of which the lots were a part that I bought of John Shale, and my will
is that she have what wood or timber & she has occasion for off the land bought
of Mr. Tarrant, given to my son John.

Item my will is that my Personal estate Consisting of Negroes etc be equally divided

among my Children vizt John, Hugh, George, William & Sybil and I give and bequeath unto
my Friend Mr. Nathaniel Chapman the tract of land that I bought of Thomas Whitford
and Robert King lying on four mile run to him and his heirs forever.

The Lotto I have in the Town of Alexandria remaining not yet bequeathed, I give and
bequeath to my four sons and their heirs forever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this ninth day of February one thousand seven hundred and fifty
four.
