In the name of God amen James Robertson Senior of Fairfax County, St. Parish Virginia being old and infirm of body though of perfect sense and memory blessed be god for it Do make & design this to be my last Will and Testament Vizt First I commit my soul to the care of my blessed Lord God of whom I had it hoping to find his blessed mercy and likewise the mercy of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ & my body to the ground to be buried decently at the discretion of my Executor and I leave my worldly estate in manner as follows Vizt Item first I give and bequeath to my well beloved son John Robertson the tract of land I now live on containing six hundred and thirty acres Except in case that they Alexanders should obtain that tract of land adjoining Todd & Evans and if so be then my daughter Jennet Bowmaker Robertson is to have three hundred and twenty acres of the said John Robertson land Secondly I give and bequeath to my well beloved daughter Jennet Bowmaker Robertson the tract of land adjoining Todd & Evans containing six hundred and thirty acres Thirdly I give and bequeath to my granddaughter Elizabeth Robertson daughter to James Robertson Junr.

One hundred acres of land beginning on four miles run and running according to the course of the said land and the remainder of the said tract I give and bequeath to my well beloved son James Robertson No. 3. I give to my son John Robertson my Desk & to my daughter Jannet Robertson my round Table & the rest of my Goods and chattles moveables and every individual to be equally divided between my wife Elizabeth Robertson & my daughter Jannet Boumaker Robertson and my son John Robertson them freely to be posset & enjoyed & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannull all & every other former Testaments Wills and Legacies requests and Executors by me in any ways before this time named willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this forth day of September in the year of our Lord God 1768.
