Justice in the Commission of the peace for Fairfax County for and in behalf to
the solemn and belief of the Justices of the said County & their successors in the
sum of two hundred pounds Sterling to be paid to the said William Fairfax Esq^r
and assignees to the which payments well and truly to be made we bind our
selves and every of us our and every of our heirs Executors and adm^r jointly and
severally finally by these presents sealed with our seals dated the 15th day of
March 1743.

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas
Beach jun^r adm^r of all the goods Chattels & Credits of James Beach dec^d deceased
or laws to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods
Chattels and Credits of the said Dec^d which have or shall come to the hands
possession or knowledge of the said Thomas or into the hands or possession
of any other person or persons for him & the same so made & exhibit or cause
to be exhibited into the said County Court of Fairfax at such time as he shall be
thereto required by the said Court & the same goods Chattels & Credits & all other
the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Dec^d at the time of his death which
at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the said Thomas
or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him do
well and truly adm^r according to Law & further do make a just and true acc^t
of his actings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court &
all the rest and residue of the said goods Chattels and Credits which shall be
found remaining upon the said adm^r amount the same being first examined
and allowed by the Justices of the Court for the time being shall deliver and
pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Justices by their order
or judgments shall direct pursuant to the Laws in that behalf made and
provided & if it shall hereafter appear that any last will & Testament was
made by the said Dec^d & the Ex^r or Ex^{rs} thereto named do exhibit the same
into the said Court making request to have it allowed and approved accordingly
if the said Thomas being thereto required do order & deliver up the
Letters of adm^r approbation of such Testaments being first had & made
in the said Court then this obligation to be void otherwise
