in form and manner following Inprimis I recom-
mend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that
gave it me and my body to the Earth to be

Buried in a decent christian like manner at the discretion of my Executor hereafter mentioned and as for such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me in this life I give & bequeath in form and manner following, Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son & William Keen and the heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten one hundred and sixty five acres of Land lying on the ruin of Pohick begining at my Upper line to him his heirs for ever,

Item I do give unto my beloved son Nicholas Keen and his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body one hundred acres of Land being the plantation whereon I now dwell with all buildings thereto belonging the said Hundred acres adjoining his brother William.

Item I do will and Bequeath to my beloved son Francis Keen and the heirs of his body Lawfully begotten one hundred acres of Land adjoining to his Brothers William and Nicholas Likewise to Richard Rogers with all appurtenances thereto belonging,

Item I do will and bequeath to my beloved son John Keen and his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body one hundred acres of Land adjoining to his brothers Nicholas and Francis with all appurtenances thereto belonging to him his heirs for ever

Item I do will and bequeath unto my beloved son James Keen and the heirs of Body Lawfully begotten one hundred acres of Land adjoining to Nicholas & John Likewise to John

Item I do bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Jane and the Lawfull heirs of her Body one negro named Joe and I do ordain that she shall therewith be satisfied and not lay claim any other part or Lot of my other Effects

Item I do bequeath to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth a negro Girl named Bess her and her increase forever Likewise a cow and calf and I do ordain that she shall therewith be satisfied and not lay claim to any other part or Lot of any other of my Effects

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Item I do bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary one
negro man named Jack to her & her heirs Lawfull

Item I do bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Stacy
one negroe man named Harry to her & her heirs Lawfull

Item I do bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sarah the
first negro child that shall happen to be born whether Male
or female of any of the negro women aforementioned with its increase
if any should happen forever or to her heirs lawfully begotten

Likewise a covenant call Sa feather bed and Furniture and I do
ordain that she shall be therewith satisfied without laying
claim to any part or lot of any other of my Effects

Item I do further ordain that all my other Household goods and
Chattles over and above what is here mentioned to be appraised
in due order and the product thereof to be equally divided
between William Keen Nicholas Keen Francis Keen John
Keen Mary Keen & Macy Keen and them only

Item I do further ordain that my wearing apparel to be equally
divided between my three youngest sons Nicholas Francis &
John and them only

Item I do ordain my son Nicholas shall be left at his own
disposal with his part and Lot of my Estate and his brother
Francis to remain with him and his part and lot of my
estate untill he shall be of full age

Item I do ordain my sons William and Nicholas Keen to
be the executors of this my Last will and Testament
