Servants Servitude - I give and bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Hey this feather bed which I now lie on only my Father to have the use of it his life time I give and bequeath unto Mary Love the daughter of Thomas Love the best bed but one which I have - I give and bequeath unto Martha Bozmon and her Sister Betty Bozmon the Bed with my Servant man lies on to be divided equally between them - I give and bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Hey the gray horse called Ficture only my Father to have the Use of him his lifetime - I give and bequeath unto Charles Love the Son of Thomas Love my Sorrel Horse during his natural Life - I give and bequeath unto my Sister Ann Love my side Saddle and Furniture - It is my desire that my part of the rest of my Estate may be equally divided amongst my dear Husbands Children Sarah Hays Martha Bozmon & Betty Bozmon - Only one Cow and Calf to Mary Love the daughter of Thomas Love I do hereby make and ordain constitute and appoint Thomas Love and David Lyon Joynt Ex^{rs} of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made as witness my hand and Seal the 15th day of January 1754
