In the Name of God Amen I John Patterson of y^e Town of Alexandria in y^e Colony of Virginia Somer being in Perfect Health of body & of Perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God calling unto mind y^e mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last

Will & Testament. That is to say. Principally and first of all. I Give & Recommend my Soul a
into the hand of almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to y^e earth nothing Doubting
but at y^e General Resurrection I shall receive y^e same again by y^e mighty Power of God. And
as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this Life. I Give
 demise and Dispose of y^e same in y^e following manner & form

First I Give to Susanna my Dearly beloved wife full Power to Dispose every thing I am Possessor of
both Real & Personal now or may be hereafter & Especially two Lots of Land in y^e afo^d Town of
Alexandria. Number Fifty one & Fifty two with y^e Appurtenances & Tenements by her freely to be
Possessed & Enjoyed while she Remains a Widow & to provide a suitable gentle Education & Living for
my three beloved Children. (to wit) William. Thomas & Betty. But in case y^e said Susanna my
wife alters her State by Matrimony (or any other method not to y^e advantage of my afo^d Children)
in such case to have then no other part of my Estate but what y^e Law allows (her third) And I
also constitute make. ordain. Susanna my wife Sole executrix of this my Last Will & Testament
and after her death my two afo^d two Lots of Land Number Fifty one & Fifty two in y^e afo^d Town
to be sold and Divided with y^e other part of my Estate between my three Children. William. Thomas.
and Betty as shall be Judged best for y^e good of them. all & I do furthermore. give. grant. full
Power to my wife Susanna to purchase (in case I do not purchase before I go for Europe) a negro
girl out of my Estate for my afo^d Daughter Betty to her & her Lawfull heirs forever. to
enjoy a negro & her Issue without y^e least molestation from any person whatsoever. And in
case any of my three Children. William. Thomas or Betty should die without Lawfull Issue his or
her share to devolve or be Divided equally between y^e party or parties surviving their brother or
Sister. And y^e better to secure to my afo^d Daughter Betty y^e afo^d Negro girl & her breed I Appoint
that my Daughter Betty & her Lawfull Children. shall enjoy a negro girl & her breed and not be
sold or divided at any Rate during my beloved Daughters natural Life but after her Death to be divided
amongst y^e Lawfull heirs of her body as she may think proper & in case she Hath no Children
Lawfully begotten then said negro & her breed to be Divided between her brothers. William & Thomas
Patterson or their Lawfull begotten Children. And I do hereby utterly disavow. revoke &
Disannul all & every other former Testaments. Wills. Legacies. Bequests & Executors by me
in any ways before named. willed & bequeathed. ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my
Last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this
Sixth day of October in y^e year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Sixty five
