I give and bequeath to my Son William Handel Merchant in London and my Daughter Ann Ruth Harvey the whole remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between them my will is that out of my Daughters proportion of fifty pounds be paid my Son in Law Lucas Harvey for mourning, I constitude and appoint John Dalton, George Gilpin and Robert Hanson Harrison Executors of this my last Will & Testament respecting all others by me hitherto made dated this first day of November 1775.
