I give and bequeath unto Martha Bozmon and her Sister Betty Bozmon the Bed wch my Servant man lies on to be divided equally betw^{en} them. I give and bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Key the gray horse called Picture only my Father to have the Use of him his lifetime. I give and bequeath unto Charles Love the Son of Thomas Love my Sorrel Horse during his natural Life. I give and bequeath unto my Sister Ann Love my side Saddle and Turniture. It is my desire that my part of the rest of my Estate may be equally divided amongst my dear Husband's Children Sarah Keys Martha Bozmon & Betty Bozmon. Only one Cow and calf to Mary Love the daughter of Thomas Love I do hereby make and ordain constitute and appoint Thomas Love and David Lyon Joynt Ex^{rs} of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made as witness my hand and Seal the 4th day of January 1754
