decent manner at the Directions of my two hereafter mentioned and as for what worldly Estate
I shall pleased God to bless me with I do give Devise and Dispose thereof in the Followinge
Manner first I will and Devise that all my just Debts be paid

Item I give and bequeath unto my eldest son Nicholas Reagan a brother before Furniture
likewise I give and bequeath four hundred Acres of land unto the said Nicholas Reagan out of
this tract where I now live on to him and his two lawfully begotten of his Body and in default
of such law to be equally divided Amongst the Rest of my Children that is to say Sarah
Reagan which is the wife of Mr. Solber to Ann Reagan constant Reagan Ains, Mildred
Reagan and these two lawfully be gotten of their Body

Item I give and Bequeath to other Reagan a brother Bed and Furniture likewise I give and
Bequeath to Constant Reagan a gether bed and Furniture and likewise I give and bequeath
unto others Reagan a gether bed and furniture. Item I give and bequeath unto Constant
Reagan and Mildred Reagan the Remainder of this tract of Land to be Equally Divided
Between them both also the tract of Land at the new church wherein The traffas lies
to be Delivere to them at the age of Eighteen or at the Day of marriage to them and their
Male line lawfully begotten of their Body on the Default of such line to be returned to my well
Beloved son Nicholas Reagan to him and his line for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto

My son Michael Reagan one Shilling Starling in Debarring him of any claim Rite or
title to any part of my Estate hereafter having given him more all ready than his parts
of the Estate would come to. Item I give and Bequeath unto Margaret Ash for a suit of Cloes
in Debarring her of any claim Rite or title to any part of my Estate having given her part
all ready. Item I give and Bequeath unto my self Beloved wife Rebekah Reagan
all the Rest of my Estate in using her natural life including this plantation where I

Now live on, it is my will and Desire that she shall not be Debare of any Timber or any wife=
- son to Supply the Plantation and after her Deceas to Dispose of the Estate as she thinks proper among the
children, it is my will and Desire that she will give a Equal part with the rest and to my Grand Daugh-
- ter Sarah Reagan the Daughter of Peter Reagan, to be paid, at eighteen or at the Day of Marriage I
acknowleage this to be my last will and Testament and I appoint my well Beloved wife Rebekah Reagan
and my son Nicholas Reagan to be hole and sole Exec^r to this my will and seal this 25th
of March 1750.
