I Recommend my Soul to almighty God that gave it and my body to the Earth to be buried in decent manner at the Direction of my Ex^{ts} hereafter mentioned and as for what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow on me with I do give Devise and Dispose thereof in the following manner first I will and Ordain that all my Just Debts be paid

Item I give and bequeath unto my last son Nicholas Heagan a feather Bed and Furniture likewise I give and bequeath four hundred Acres of Land unto the said Nicholas Heagan out of this tract where I now live on to him and his line lawfully begotten of his Body and in default of such line to be Equally divided Amongst the Heirs of my Children that is to say Land Heagan which is the Wife of M^r. Tolbert to Ann Heagan Constant Heagan And Milnes Heagan and their line lawfully be gotten of their Body

Item I give and Bequeath to Ann Heagan a feather Bed and Furniture likewise I give and Bequeath to Constant Heagan a feather bed and Furniture and likewise I give and bequeath unto Milnes Heagan a feather bed and furniture. Item I give and bequeath unto Constant Heagan and Milnes Heagan the Remainder of this tract of Land to be Equally Divided between them both after three tracts of Land at the new Church whereon Thos. Gaffes lives to be Delivered to them at the age of eighteen or at the Day of Marriage to them and their Male line lawfully begotten of their Body in default of such line to be returned to my well Beloved Son Nicholas Heagan to him and his line for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Michael Heagan one Shilling Sterling in Debaring him of any Claim Right or title to any part of my Estate hereafter having given him more all ready than his parts of the Estate would come to. Item I give and Bequeath unto Margaret Ash for a suit of Cloes in Debaring her of any Claim Right or title to any part of my Estate having given her part all ready. Item I give and Bequeath unto my well Beloved Wife Rebecca Heagan all the Rest of my Estate inuring from natural life including this Plantation where I

Now live on, it is my will and Desire that she shall not be Debarred of any Timber or any Tree =
= say to supply the Plantation and after her Decease to Dispose of the Estate as she thinks proper among the
children, it is my will and Desire that she will give a Equal part with the rest and to my Grand Daugh-
= ter Sarah Reagan the Daughter of Peter Reagan, to be paid, at eighteen or at the Day of Marriage I
acknowledge this to be my last will and Testament and I appoint my well Beloved wife Rebecca Reagan
and my son Nicholas Reagan to be hole and sole Exec^{rs} As Witness my hand and Seal this 25th
of March 1750
