 to settle the affairs of this life as to my worldly goods & debts
 & demands & rights & property whatsoever I give to sell beloved wife
 Ellenor during her widowhood accounting it so long as her
 keeping from marring or having a child by any man upon these
 terms it is to be held as long as she lives & as to my dear mother
 that brought me into this world she is to have a maintenance
 for her estate that was left by her husband which was in Will-
 iam & Richard Kents hands therefore I desire that the estate
 that has been received in our hands that there be men choiced to
 divide it equally between them & then if mother is uneasy that
 they give their bond & security such as she thinks proper and as to
 my sister Mary that takes care of her mother and living upon her
 own means free from any thing that is found her mother therefore
 let her claim come out of what is in her mothers hands now accord to
 the above return if it be continued in phrasing that it be good but upon
 the failing that the Executors doe make sail of the same my goods &
 portions — I keep it till my three children come to be of age &
 namely Nancy & Mary & John which then divide equally between
 them this is my last Will & Testament and I hereby ordain John
 Reed & John Hampton my noty Executors witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this 6th Day of September 1770.
