 God one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight I Rebeccah Wheeler widow of the
 Deceast Richard Wheeler of Shrop parish in the County of Fairfax being weak of
 body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto
 mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and
 first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my body
 I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and Decent manner at the discretion
 of my Executors not doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
 by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God
 to bless me in this life I give Devise and Dispose in the following manner and form
 First I give and Bequeath to my dearly beloved daughter Susanna Williams and
 Susanna Simpson all my wearing Cloths to be Equally divided betwixt them
 Likewise to my dearly beloved son Edward Davis my own bed and Furniture thereto
 belonging.
 likewise to William Grizzell the bed and Furniture thereto belonging that he may
 together with the whole crop of corn wheat and Tobacco on the ground or in the houses
 at my decease likewise I will that my household Furniture horses Cattle hogs be Equally
 Divided betwixt the aforesaid Edward Davis and William Grizzell

I likewise make constitute and Ordain the said William Fricell my only and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly Disallow Revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills and Legacies requests and eas. by me in any ways before this time named willed and Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
