In the name of God Amen. April the sixteenth day in the year of our Lord
God one thousand seven hundred and fifty eight I Rebecca Wheeler relict of the
Deceast Richarda Wheeler of Irro parish in the County of Fairfax being weak of
body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefor calling unto
mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is Appointed for all men once to
die do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and
first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it, and for my body
I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and Decent manner at the discretion
of my Executors not doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God
to bestow on me in this life I give Devise and Dispose in the following manner and form
First I give and Bequeath to my dearly beloved daughters Susanna Williams and
Susanna Simpson all my wearing Cloths to be Equally divided betwixt them
Likewise to my dearly beloved son Edward Davis my own bed and Furniture thereto
belonging
likewise to William Frizell the bed and Furniture thereto belonging that he lyson
together with the whole crop of corn wheat and Tobacco on the ground or in the houses
at my Decease likewise I will that my household Furniture horses Cattle hogs be Equally
Divided betwixt the abovesaid Edward Davis and William Frizell

I Likewisemake constitute and ordain the said William Frixell my only and
sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly Disallow
Revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments wills and Legacies
requests and Ex. by me in any ways before this time named, willed and Bequea-
thd Transfying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.

above written.
