 whole and sole Executor of this my last will & Testament in witness
 whereof I have set my hand & affixed my seal this 4th day of April 1743.

1743.

& singular the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased which he or she shall
have to his hands possession or knowledge of the said Executors or into his hands
or possession of any other person or persons for the time the said some how do
inhibit or cause to be inhibited into the County Court of Fairfax at such time as
they shall be thereto required by the said Court & the said goods Chattels &
Credits & all other the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased at the time of
his death or within any time after shall come to the hands or possession of
the said Executors or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons
for the time do well & truly administer according to Law & further do make a
just & true account of their castings & doings therein when thereto required
by the said Court and also do well & truly pay & deliver all the Legacies contained
