I Give to the care of old Gilbert Simpson and his son Gilbert Simpson & to of the care and bringing up of my four Children in a good Christian manner

I Love my Daughter Catharine Preston and my son Robert Preston to the care of young Gilbert Simpson &c

I Love my son Thomas Preston and John Preston to his son Gilbert Simpson

I Give all the rest and residue of my estate of what sort or kind soever after my just debts are paid and satisfied I will and desire may be equally divided between my Children and their heirs forever

I Do declare and appoint the said Gilbert Simpson and his son Gilbert Simpson Executors of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this ninth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty seven Robert P. Preston
