be my last will & Testament in manner & form following as first I give & bequeath
bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my heavenly Father hoping that
through the merits & satisfaction of Jesus Christ my Lord & Saviour to receive
His pardon & forgiveness of all my sins & to obtain a joyfull resurrection at
the last day & as for my body to be buried in the consecration of my last will & Testament
as aforesaid.

Now I give and bequeath to my son Richard Hickland all my right title and
claim which I have to a tract of Land containing to hundreds acres of Land
being known by the name of Browns former lying & being in Baltimore
County

Now I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary the plantation on
which I now live & all the Land belonging thereto during the term of her
natural life & after her decease to my son Robert Hickland & his heirs for
ever my son Robert Hickland paying my son John Hickland ten pounds
current money of Virginia

Now all my moveable estate I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife
Mary during the term of her natural life & after her decease to be equally

Kirkland deceased do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all &
singular the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased which have or shall
come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Mary & George or into
the hands & possession of any other person or persons for them & the said do
make & exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the County Court of Fairfax at
such time as they shall be thereunto required by the said Court & the same goods
Chattels & Credits & all other the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased at
the time of his Death or which at any time after shall come to the hands or
possession of the said Mary & George or into the hands or possession of any
other person or persons for them, do well & truly adm^t. according to Law
