through the merits & satisfaction of Jesus Christ my Lord & Saviour to receive  
his pardon & forgiveness of all my sins & to obtain a joyfull resurrection at  
the last day & as for my body to be buried at the discretion of my next of kin  
& unincumbered.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Richard Hickland all my right title and  
claim which I have to a tract of Land containing four hundred acres of Land  
being known by the name of Browns former lying & being in Baltimore  
County

Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary the plantation on  
which now live call the Land belonging therunto during the term of her  
natural life & after her decease to my son Robert Hickland & his heirs for  
ever my son Robert Hickland paying my son John Hickland ten pounds  
current money of Virginia

Item all my moveable estate I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife  
Mary during the term of her natural life & after her decease to be equally  
Divided amongst all my Sons & Daughters

Item I appoint my well beloved wife Mary & George (allord) to be my Ex<sup>rs</sup> of  
this my last Will & Testament.

singular the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased which have or shall  
come to the hands possession or enjoyment of the said Mary & George or into  
the hands & possession of any other person or persons for them & the said do  
make or exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the County Court of Fairfax at  
such time as they shall be thereunto required by the said Court & the same goods  
Chattels & Credits & all other the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased at  
the time of his Death or which at any time after shall come to the hands or  
possession of the said Mary & George or into the hands or possession of any  
other person or persons for them do well & truly adm. according to Law

to further discharge a just & true account of their actings & things therein, which shalbe
