have a good & lawfull Deed made for the said Land when Demanded Lastly it is my will and desire that my loving wife Eleanor Videl and my Grand Son of the Videl be Executors to this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 18th day of October one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy two

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Carson of the Town of Alexandria being sick but of sound and disposing mind do make this my last Will and Testament.

Whereas the said Thomas Carson and James Muir on the first day of May in the year one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy two Entered into the following Articles of Copartnership Viz. Memorandum May the 1st 1772. That Thomas Carson and James Muir entered into joint partnership Each to advance three hundred and fifty pounds Currency for the term of three years and Renewable then if agreeable to both and that in case either of them die before the Expiration that the Survivor partner should take an inventory of Goods on hand and after all the debts due from us jointly are paid the Ballance should be Remitted to those to whom the same should be left as soon as the debts due us are collected NOW The said Thomas Carson do hereby ratify and confirm the said Articles in every part and do hereby direct and Order that my Executors shall sell and dispose of in Fee simple my part or part of a Lot which I purchas

Purchased as a Tenant in Common with James Muir for to pay and discharge my part of the joint Debts due by me and the said James Muir in case there may remain any after the said James Muir shall have sold the Goods now upon hand belonging to us jointly and Collected such debts as may be due and owing to us and that the Surplus of the money arising from the Sale, after payment of the said deficiency in case there may be any shall be paid to John Carson and Jennet Carson my Brother and Sister and to the Children of David Menish to be Equally divided among all of them as also the Surplus of any money that may remain of the joint partnership debts between I and the said James Muir after the joint debts are fully paid and satisfied And I do make and constitute my Friends John Muir and Thomas Kirkpatrick of the Town of Alexandria Executors of this my last will In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 17th October 1774
