whatsoever shall be in the upper Drawer of the Case Drawers in my bed
Chamber at the time of my Death.

Item I give unto John West Junr Hogarth's Prints.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Doctor Rumney amare Colt now in
his profession.

Item. I give and Bequeath unto Elizabeth Ramsay my Spinnet now
in her profession.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Benjamin Moody all the
Residue of my Estate desiring him to take care of Negro. Sall for my
Sake and I do hereby appoint the said Benjamin Moody to be my
whole and Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament.

Item I desire no Inventory of my Estate may be made nor any
Funeral Sermon.

continuance of my life and being desirous to leave that Estate which God
has blessed me with in my Family with as much peace and union as may
be and that I may have nothing of this world or its entanglements to
encumber my thoughts when I am going out of it, do make this my last
will and Testament in manner and form following.

Imprimis. I will and empower my Executors herein after named as
soon as conveniently they can after my decease and upon such Credit
as they shall think fit, to sell all my household Furniture, Stocks of
horses, Cattle, Hogs and Shop Plantation Utensils and all other my
personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever (except my Slaves) and
apply the purchase money to the payment of my Debts. I also will and
empower my said Executors or the Survivor or Survivors of them to sell
my Lands in the Province of Maryland, as soon as they conveniently
can and upon such Credit as they shall think fit and the money
arising from the Sale of the said Lands and the Balance of my
personal Estate above mentioned (if any remains after paying my
Debts) to be by them or the Survivor of them applied to the payment of a
Debt due from my Son Leon to William Balmain of Alexandria
Merchant and likewise in payment for two Lots situate in the Town of
Colchester Contracted for by myself one with M^r Cumberland & Milson
for my Son Leon and the other with M^r William Sempleman for my
Son Sall which Contracts I desire may be carried into Execution by my
Executors and the Conveyances be made to my said Sons Leon and
Sall and their heirs for ever of their respective Lots accordingly and
the oversplus of the Money arising from the Sales of my Personal
Estate & Marylands as aforesaid, after payment of my Debts
and of the several Sums above specified I give to my four Daughters
