The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound Sarah McLarty adm^r with the will annexed of Denis McLarty gent do or do not make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels & Credits of the said Denis which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Sarah or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her & the said Denis do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the County Court of Fairfax at such time as she shall be thereto required by the said Court & the said Goods Chattels & Credits & all the other Goods Chattels & Credits of the said Denis at the time of his Death or which at any time after shall come to the hands & possession of the said Sarah or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her do well & truly administer according to Law & further do make a just & true account of her actings & Doings thereunto as thereto required by the said Court & all for well & truly pay & Deliver all the Legacies contained & specified in the said Testament as far as the said Goods Chattels & Credits will therunto extend according to the value thereof & the Law shall charge her thereto this obligation to be void & of no force
