our said Executors made jointly & severally firm by them presents same  
with our seals & dated this 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1743.

This condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound Sarah Mc Larty and with her will annexed of Denis Mc Larty gent doth do  
make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular her  
goods, chattels & credits of her and Denis which have or shall come to her  
hands possession or knowledge of this said Sarah or into the hands or possession  
of any other person or persons for her use & service to exhibit or cause  
to be exhibited into the County Court of Fairfax at such time as this shall be  
hereafter required by this said Court of her said goods, chattels & credits of her  
goods, chattels & credits of this said Denis at the time of his Death or which shall  
have after shall come to the hands & possession of this said Sarah or into the  
hands or possession of any other person or persons for her use & service to  
administer according to law & further to make a just & true account of his auctings &  
Dungs wherein shall hereafter required by this said Court & sold over & truly pa  
& delivered all his legacies contained & specified in this said Testament as  
far as his said Goods, chattels & credits will thereto extend according to the  
value thereof & the Law shall charge her that this obligation to be void & in  
force
