of Essex but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for the same do make & ordain this  
my last will and testament in manner and form as follows. In witness whereof I give and bequeath  
to my well beloved wife Jane Morley if two of one negro boy named Tom during her life  
and after her decease I give the said negro boy to my son Daniel Morley and his heirs.  
Item I give to my wife the use of one feather bed and furniture during her life Item I bequeath  
give to my said wife the use of two cows and calves & to have the first choice during her  
life I bequeath give to my said wife during her life the use of one horse or mares either  
choice Item I also give to my wife Jane Morley a servant woman named Anna White  
During her continuall I also give to my wife a woman called Mrs. and brother During her life  
Item I give to my son Daniel Morley a negro boy named George & one feather bed and  
furniture to him and his heirs Item I give to my son Thomas Morley a negro boy  
named Harry & a feather bed and furniture which I left to his mother after her  
decease to him & his heirs Item I give to my son Nathaniel Morley a negro girl  
named Patt to him and his heirs Item if either of my three sons Samuel Thomas  
or Nathaniel should die before they arrive to the age of eighteen years or within twelve  
hours then what I have given him to be sold & the money arising therefrom to be  
equally divided between the two surviving brothers Item I give to my wife Jane  
Morley the plantation I now live on during her life and after her decease I give this  
said plantation to my son Daniel Morley Item I give to my daughter Sibbel Bush  
two large Pounds due to be delivered to her after the death of my wife Item I give to  
my daughter Hannah Morgan two large Pounds due to be delivered to her after the  
death of my wife Item I give Martha Deling a feather bed and furniture to be delivered  
to her after the death of my wife Item I give to my Daughters in law Jane Walling &  
Anne Rials twenty shillings of like money I also give to my Daughters Elizabeth Loxe  
twenty shillings of like money if ever they come to demand it and my desire is that  
all the remainder part of my estate to be sold and the money to be equally divided  
between my sons Daniel Samuel Thomas & Nathaniel Morley & my two daughters

I also leave my two sons Harry Bush and Nathaniel Morley to be of age when they come to the age of eighteen years and in states I have left them to be delivered to them when they come to that age it is my desire that my son Nathaniel Morley should be bound to a profitable trade by my Executors hereafter named. I likewise leave my three sons to the care of Gerard - Doling & what he have given them till they come to the age of eighteen years then may they be left to my son Samuel it is my desire he should help support the rest of his young children till they come to of age I likewise give the care of my children & the rest of my effects to my wife during her widowhood. I also constitute & appoint my son Daniel Morley & Gerard Doling my trustees and executors of this my last will and testament as witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this third day of March on the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty two -
