Available is a Commission issued from the County Court of Henrico to us directed on this day proceeded to examine the amount of the Appleberry debt of William Appleberry dead and from the foregoing statement there appears to be due to the widow of William Appleberry, decedent, seven hundred and twenty six dollars 58 cents out of the net proceeds of the personal Estate of said decedent subject to a deduction of her purchases at the sale. We also find after the widow's share deducted from the amount of sale of the personal estate the sum of One hundred and three dollars 79 cents due to each Legatee arising out of the net proceeds of the sale of the personal estate & after deducting for it being the widow's share as aforesaid. Given under our hands this 15 day of January 1816.
