 is that after all my just debts and funeral expenses are paid the re-  
 mainder of my estate be disposed of as follows Viz. First my will  
 and desire is that my negro man Dick shall live with my son Wil-  
 liam J Cole with a request that he will treat him in a just and  
 decent manner during his life provided my said son William should die before the said  
 negro Dick my desire is then the said Dick shall have it in his power to  
 make choice of living with either of my other children at his own discre-  
 tion secondly the money which I borrowed of my late wife Anne Cole  
 and William J Cole the sum of one hundred dollars of the said  
 said Anne for which I gave a Bond and a Note to the said William  
 and the sum of two hundred dollars of the said Anne and the said  
 William J Cole for my said wife's and the said Anne's

 Clerks therein named to qualify thereto.
