In the name of God, Amen. The nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five I Augustus Shepherd of the County of Fluvanna being at this time weak in body but of sound mind and Memory, and calling to mind the Mortality of my body, the Uncertainty of this life and Certainty of Death do make Ordain this to be my last will and Testament (Utterly Revoking all former Wills and Testaments) In manner and form hereafter Mentioned. Item It is my will that James Barnett who I do Appoint and constitute my Executor to have my last Will and Testament, so after my death possess of or dispose of his property my several more Bundles and one pair of Saddle Bags provided he pays to my Niece Polly Hunt the just and full sum of Fifty pounds current money of Virginia when she should arrive at lawful age or should Marry But provided she should die before she should arrive to lawful age or die without lawful issue Then and in that case the said Fifty pounds shall revert to my Nephew Augustus Barnett to have and his heirs forever.

Item I give to my Nephew John Perkins my young Bay Horse to be enjoyed by him and his heirs forever. Item I give my Nephew John B. Shepherd my Riding saddle to him and his heirs forever. Item I desire that no Appraisement be on my Estate given under my hand and seal as my last Will and Testament this day witnessed above.
