the County of Rockland and Parish of St James Parish State of Virginia being
at this present time of sound mind and memory thought to signify that
as I am now and again this my last Will and Testament hereby making
it shall be by me hereafter made Viz. I am by my Will and desire to
first after my death that my body be decently buried at the discretion of
my executor hereafter named. I am by my Will and desire to give to
one after my death as conveniently can be all my just debts to duly paid
I am by my Will and desire to give to my two sisters Ann Pace and Jane Pace all
my real and personal during their natural or single life and in
the event of the death or marriage of either the other to have and to
hold the same during her natural or single life and at the death or
marriage of both my above named sisters my Will and desire is that
all my real and personal be equally divided between my two
daughters and sisters (by my deceased Mother) to them and their
heirs forever. Lastly I do constitute and appoint my brother Robert
of this my last Will and Testament referring that trust and
power as he may or as from time to time to receive - In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
