my real and personal during their natural or single life, and in
the event of the death or marriage of either the other to have and to
keep the same during her natural or single life and at the death or
of both my above named sisters my Will and desire is that
real and personal be equally divided between my sur-
viving sisters (by my deceased Mother) to them and their
heirs. Lastly I do constitute and appoint my brother Robert
of this my last Will and Testament, exposing that he will and
do as he may or do from time to time - In
