as follows (to wit) Item I give and bequeath unto my son
Abner Sayre one hundred and ten acres of Land lying in
Goodland County, adjoining John Martin being the Land whereon
he now lives — Item I give unto my son Jacob Bradshaw
Sayre one hundred acres of Land lying over the creek adjoining
Shadrach Walker being the Land whereon he now
lives — Item I give and bequeath unto my son Elisha Sayre
one hundred and fifty acres of Land being the place
whereon I now live, also one gun and one pair of

the remaining part of my Estate not already settled
I give and bequeath one half of the same to my

son John and the other half I give unto my wife
during her life and at her death I give and bequeath the same
unto my said son Elisha Sayre — Item I give unto my other
children (to wit) Samuel Sayre, John Sayre, Fanny Sayre,
Lucy Martin, Judith Howard, and Molly Bagby one
shilling each — Lastly I constitute nominate and ordain
my son Elisha Sayre my Executor to this my last Will
and Testament & also desire there shall be no appraisement
