22^d day of December 1871. This Sarsbury and appreciation of the sale of Mrs.
Lefevre's property &c. was then paid returned and ordered to be paid.

In the Name of God Amen I George Burgess of Massachusetts being
 sick of body but of sound mind and memory do hereby certify and declare that my last
 Will and Testament touching all other little words by me.

1st My Will and desire is that the two Negroes thought out of my children sold.
Namely Sebill and Nancy after the payment of forty dollars shall be then, given
up the 100 Acres of Land which I sold Joseph Pennell for and in consideration of
the legacy left here by George Saunders to him, and the three fourths of the same to
Lucy Thomas daughter of Betty Thomas and her mother. My Son George being dead,
Said man was his heir of which he is possessed at the present time. I desire
give to my Daughter Betty Mary her share of the same and the other half of the
Said man's share the whole of the balance of my estate and the interest of the same
during her natural life and then to be divided equally between my Son George and my
Daughter Mary and their heirs forever.
