Item first I bequeath that all my just debts shall be paid
Item Second I give unto my son Joshua Bartley two Acres by
the names of Tom & Hannah a good spoke of Sticks & be bound
to him & his heirs forever Item Third I give unto my Grand
children Sons & Daughters of Eliza Ballenger one and a half Acres
I own by the name of Lewis and the sum of one hundred
& ten pounds in specie or a Negro which I may purchase
with the said money to them & their heirs
Item Fourth I give unto my Grand children Sons & Daughters
of Frances Gibson one and a half Acres by the names of Delphina
& Phyllis to be equally divided between them & their heirs forever
Item fifth I give unto my Daughter Phoebe Bartley two
Acres by the names of Caleb & Maria & their heirs in
case one farther Son & daughter was born & the free children
belonging one boy now called Betty all my Current choice
of my Tools & household goods & what a part
paid & piggion four of the choice of my Stock of Sheep
Item Sixth I give unto my Grand daughter Abigail

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belonging promise the said Abigail she should use have com-
pleted her Education before my death Item Eighth
I come in assurance to what I have heretofore given my
son Joshua Bartley that he shall have all my Carpenter
tools & Musicians tools also my smaller Bone Gun
also Trailing Gun all my right and title to the Land where
in I now live to him the same having and therefore
given him & by his trustees use to John S. Bragg
Item Ninth I desire that all the debts as of my death
not heretofore mentioned after my death shall be paid by
my Executors hereafter named and the money arising
from the sale to be equally divided between my Grand child-
ren that is those living who are the Sons & Daughters of
my deceased Daughter Joanna Bragg Lastly I do
appoint my son Joshua Bartley & my friend Abner
Barnard Executors to this my last Will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand

this time in a very low state of health but still being possessed
of sound mind and disposing memory so make and enact
this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form
following that is to say First my Will and desire is that
all my just debts be paid handsly. After the payment
of all my just debts all my personal property then
remaining of any kind and description whatever it is
my Will and desire may be sold by my Brethren herein
after named and the money arising from such sale
equally divided between my two Daughters Anne White and
Cathy White also my son William White and my friend

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John to their heirs forever. Truly In the afore mentioned
to properly consider to be sold I do not mean to include a
land more but now in possession of my son William
that I have intended to be his property and I hereby
give and confirm the same unto him and his heirs forever
Truly I give and bequeath unto my son William the land
and plantation whereon I now reside containing Seventy
Acres to the same more or less being all the real Estate
of which I am possessed to him and his heirs forever
forever and ever and it is my Will and desire that
so long as my two Daughters afore named are single
Daughters being Single and all at this time living
with me shall either of them remain in an unmarried
or single State and chuse to reside in the aforesaid Land
and plantation bequeathed to my son William they shall be
at full Liberty to do so and to use culture and occupy
the same as their own without my interruption or
intermeddling whatever. Truly Having given and
bequeathed to all my other children not named in this my Will
all that part of my Estate intended for them whatever I may
have so given I hereby confirm unto them and their heirs
forever Truly I constitute and appoint my son
William White and my friend Reuben Crossen Executors
