Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Richardson the land and plantation whereon I now live containing of three hundred and eight Acres of Land. to him and his heirs forever. Item my Will and desire is that all the rest of my Estate be equally divided between my five Children viz William Richardson John Richardson Mary Lee Sarah Moore Ann Jones and the sons of my Daughter Susannah Mose dec^d to have the Estate first divided amongst them of my personal Estate to them and their heirs forever to be paid to them as they come of age.
