In the name of God Amen I, Mary Sneed late of the County of Goochland and Parish of St James, Subject of Virginia in this present time of sound mind and memory thanks to Almighty God do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament hereby wishing to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament hereby wishing by me herefore made this 17th day of September 1819 and desire it to be done after my death that my body be decently buried at the discretion of my known trustees named. Item my Will and desire is that is done after my death as conveniently can to all my just debts be paid and discharged. I give and bequeath to my two sisters Mary Pace and Jane Pace all my real and personal during their natural or single life and in the event of the death or marriage of either the other to have and to hold the same during her natural or single life and at the death or marriage of both my above named sisters my Will and desire is that my real and personal be equally divided between my surviving sisters and brothers (by my deceased mother) to them and their heirs. I do constitute and appoint my brother Robert of this my last Will and Testament refusing that trust and care as he may or as from time required to receive.
