County being in good health and sound judgment and memory and  
knowing that it is for all men once to die I make and declare to be  
my last will and Testament and first I desire to commend my soul to  
God that gave it and my body to be buried in a Christian like  
manner and as touching my worldly goods which it has bin  
please god to bestow on me I bestow in this manner as follows I  
give to my son Archelus Kent my land where on I now live and  
all that lye on the north side of Vinabels neck I give to my son  
Thomas Kent my land on the south side of Vinabels neck the land  
and plantation I give to my daughter Lucy Davis one hundred  
dollars to be paid by Archelus and Thoma Kent I have my ne-  
gros and all my stock and household furniture to be divided between  
Archelus Kent and Thomas Kent and making hold I have my  
son John Kent for Orphan Heir and Thomas Kent to be care  
of him and youse him well as long as he live if he die without  
a child on his part all come to the other upon the same and  
I have John White Executor of this my last will and Testament

presented on Monday the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1823. This Instru-  
ment was this day presented in Court proved to be the hand  
and signature of the said John Kent and ordered to be recorded as the last  
will and Testament of the said John Kent. And
