In the name of God Amen I Duncan McLauchlan being of sound mind but weak and in a low state of health do make this as my last will and Testament Improvements - It is my will and sense that all my last Debts should be paid out of my Estate real or Personal - and all expenses relative to my funeral which are to be judged of by my Executors herein after named. Item I give and bequeath to Duncan Quarters one thousand Pounds to him and his heirs forever - Item I give to Duncan King one hundred pounds to him and his heirs forever - The residue of my Estate Real & Personal I leave to John Quarters In trust for the benefit of my relations in Scotland
