 heirs forever. 5<sup>th</sup> I give unto my daughter Mather Bunchwood  
 two Negro girls by name Phillis and another

 ance of her life with my daughter Mather Bunchwood I  
 further gave to her a negro woman by name Bab-ala-ma, by  
 name Mithel and a negro boy by name Sam also one hund-  
 red pounds cash to her and her heirs forever. 6<sup>th</sup> I give unto  
 my daughter Rebecca Anderson one Negro girl by name Moring  
 to her and her heirs forever. 7<sup>th</sup> I give unto my daughter Appe-  
 lone Harrison one negro girl by name Betty the same being  
 in her possession I further give her a negro Boy by name George  
 to her and her heirs forever. 8<sup>th</sup> I give unto my daughter Shelton  
 Burgess a negro girl by name Bazaar. I also give her a negro boy  
 by name James to her and her heirs forever. 9<sup>th</sup> I give unto my  
 daughter Mehala Glyburn the sum of five shillings to her and  
 her heirs forever. 10<sup>th</sup> I give unto the Children of Mehala Glyburn  
 a negro woman by name Phely to be equally divided between  
 them and their heirs forever. 11<sup>th</sup> I give unto my daughter Abba  
 Blackburn the sum of five shillings to her and her heirs forever.  
 12<sup>th</sup> I give unto the Children of Abba Blackburn a negro boy by  
 name Renee them and their heirs forever. also a negro girl by name  
 Chechona to them and their heirs forever. 13<sup>th</sup> I give unto my daugh-  
 ter Sabrina Pettis a negro boy by name Daniel also a negro boy  
 by name Moses cook to her and her heirs forever. 14<sup>th</sup> I give unto  
 my daughter Thura a negro boy by name John also one hundred and  
 fifty dollars cash likewise a horse black Mare to her and her heirs  
 forever. 15<sup>th</sup> after the death; or provided my wife Anne Pettis shall  
 again marry after my death I desire that my executors hereafter  
 named sell the tract of land whereon my house stands and the  
 money arising from said sale to be equally divided among my  
 children.

shall marry again after my death dispose of  
 said land conditionally (given to her) and divide the money arising  
 from said sale between all my aforesaid children and Grand Child  
 my daughter Rebecca Anderson and her heirs which I wish to have  
 no part nor lot in such proceeds that is the children of Mehala  
 Glyburn and Abba Blackburn to have one fourth part each par-  
 cel and the balance to be equally divided among my said children.  
 And I further desire that my executors hereafter named deliver to  
 their hands what part of my estate that should fall to the share  
 of Abba Blackburn for their benefit and dispose of it for  
 their best interest and profit to them as they may find they  
 need it or otherwise without to come at it through the hands  
 of William Blackburn as I do not wish any further part of my estate  
 to fall into his hands. And lastly I constitute and appoint my  
 friends William Moor Adam Harrison Thomas Caldwell and  
 John D. Moon Executors of this my last will and testament in doing  
 revoking all former wills by me heretofore made. In witness  
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 21<sup>st</sup>  
 day of February eight hundred and twenty one.  
 And I further desire that my executors hereafter named may be  
 apprized that I have entered into a contract commencing from 1821  
 with Adam S. Harrison and will not be ended under ten years  
 from that date and should I not live until the expiration of that  
 time it is my wish the contract on my part to be fully satisfied

Lewis. Item I give unto my daughter Sally Smith, Teller  
and her increase also my negro boy Meas. Item I give unto  
my daughter Betty Richardson my negro girl Briten and my  
negro man young Tom. Item I give unto my son Dennis Payne  
my negro man Abram and my boy Daniel. Item I give  
unto my son William Payne my negro man Archer and girl Din-  
the, also old Tom and Hannah his wife. Item I give unto
