

to be specified, and at the same time made and confirmed by my ^{My} Executors hereafter to be named that ~~it is my will and desire~~ these advancements to be made unless in their opinion practicable without frustrating or disturbing my ~~will and desire~~ of my children as shall or may be living with here. — To my two sons John Shepherd and David Shepherd it is my will and desire that the sum of Ten pounds current money of Virginia be advanced for each of them as soon as practicable, in addition to what they have already received by way of advancement to them — To my son in law James Baskett I have already advanced to him one negro girl named Jiggy, and one feather Bed and furniture which I estimate at one hundred pounds value, that being as much as is intended by me to be advanced for any of my children, he said Baskett having also received of me one cow half which he must account for as a fiduciar division of my Estate — And to my other children Joanna, William Martin, Thomas, Charles, John Henderson, Frances and Mary Ann, it is my will and desire that they and each of them last named, or any of either of them shall arrive at lawful age or should marry. — It is my desire they receive from my Estate the sum of one hundred pounds in money or property, if in property to be valued by two or more respectable persons to each of them by way of advancement if thought practicable by my executors as is before mentioned. — And after the death or widowhood of my wife it is my Will and desire that all my Estate that should be then remaining of whatever nature it may be real and personal be equally divided amongst all my children that should be then living or their lawful representatives. — It is my will and desire that if any of my children should die and leave no children or representatives of children his or their parts be equally divided amongst the surviving Brothers and sisters — And lastly I do appoint, constitute and ordain my son David Shepherd my

 any description both real and personal that may remain
 after paying all my just debts & the legacies herein before mentioned
