life do make this my last will & Testament in manner and  
form following to wit first all my just debts to be paid then  
give and bequeath to my daughter Peggy Thompson after my deceas  
two thirds of my Lands and two thirds of all other property that I  
have of every description to here and there ~~here~~ forever the residue  
of my Land which is one third part I give to my daughter Sussey  
Swanson with the one third of all my other property to here and  
there forever that Lands to be laid off in such a manner  
as to give my daughter Peggy Thompson the plantation where on I now  
live also appoynted Nathan Twiford my Executor of this my last will  
and testament revoking all other wills by me made In witness  
whereof I have set my hand and prest my seal this 25  
day of May one thousand eight hundred twenty three.
