God who gave it. Secondly my Will and same is read all my dutys and funeral
charges to payd. Item I give and bequeath unto my living wife Agnes Mullen my
land and plantation wherere I now live containing one hundred acres by estimation
being ten hundred acres after her death or interravement. I then give the same to my
son John Mullen I give this land and plantation to him and his heirs forever and
in case my said son John Mullen die without heirs of his body my Will and same is
that the land above mentioned shall be equally divided amongst my other children
I give it to them and them their posterity. Item I also give and bequeath unto
my self all my Stock of Horses, cattle Hogs, and Sheep, with all my house
hold furniture plantation tools and all movables now in my possession during my
natural life or interravement and after her death or interravement I then give the same to
my son John Mullen. I give it to him and his posterity. Item I give and bequeath unto
them in without heirs of his body my same is read it shall be equally divided
amongst my other children.

Item I do hereby certify and beware this is to my last Will and Testament to which
I appernt Peirce Ware Mullen Executor & my wife Agnes Mullen Executrix of this my
last Will and Testament reading all other Wills herefore made. In witness whereof
I have counterset my hand and Seal this twenty ninth day of April one thousand
seven hundred and thirty four.

County to Raynolds Ford I give the same to him and his heirs forever
that to my said son Peirce Ware payd my Son John Mullen Fifteen pounds
Currency. Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Mullen the same
and Plantation wherere I now live being all the same that I possess on the North
side of the road leading from the Park County to Raynolds Ford after his mother death
on the 20th day of April 1795 to him and his heirs forever
in this present life my son Peirce Ware payd my daughter Elizabeth Mullen Fifteen
pounds Currency. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Mullen
the same in the same manner as she was forever. Item I give unto my
living wife Elizabeth Mullen all my estate during her natural life or interravement and
after her decease I give the same to be equally divided among all my daughters then
living. I give it to them and them heirs forever. Item I do hereby certify and beware
this to be my last Will and Testament to which I appernt my Son John Mullen
and my Son William Mullen which are sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament
reading all else with huncorpe were. In witness whereof I remmende my Soul
and Seal this Twenty ninth day of April one thousand seven hundred and thirty four.
