Item Further my desire is for the love and affection I have for my  
wife Susanna Massey I lend to her my Land with one third part  
of my Negroes and other estate during her life and the other two  
thirds of my estate during <sup>her</sup> widowhood or until my youngest child

comes of age or marries my desire is that my wife have the use of  
my estate to school and support my child <sup>hereafter named</sup> Mary

Frances Margret Eliza Ann Louisa Kate & Susanna until they  
all become of age or marries each of them to have an equal part of  
my estate but if either of them should die without having one then  
their part to be divided equally amongst all the rest of my children  
hereafter named which I give to them and their heirs forever

Item - If my wife should marry before my children come of age or  
marry and should not school <sup>support</sup> them then my desire is that my  
childrens estate be taken away from her and she shall receive and  
maintain out of their estate and to be divided amongst them as  
before divided -

Item My desire is after my wife's death that all  
the remaining part of my estate should be divided amongst my children  
hereafter named as follows
