made by me in the first place I recommending my soul to God who gave
it, and Secondly it is my Will and desire that my wife shall have and
continue in possession during her natural life or widowhood the whole
of my estate both real and personal, so that she (and mine) live in
or disposed of it in any manner whatever except it be for the immediate
use or benefit of the raising or tuition of my Children who are now under
age and will be with her

Kindly do my will and desire that my son Richard Alexander shall have the
sum of Twenty Dollars out of my estate to be paid him after the death of
myself, to my wife, to my other person and also to my will in,
I have hereunto given hand.

Fourthly It is my will and desire that my Daughter Mary Howard shall have the sum of two Collars as also that her said Mary Howard's Daughter Polly shall have a further sum and provided to be worth twenty Collars all of which is to take effect after the death or intermarriage of my Wife. Fifth It is my will and desire that my son Elliott Howard shall have the sum of thirty Collars to be paid him out of my estate after the death or intermarriage of my Wife.

Light it is my will and desire that my son, John, shall have the
 sum of one hundred dollars to be paid him out of my estate after the death
 or interment of my wife

records, it is my wish and prayer that my son George Harrison should have the sum of thirty dollars to be paid him out of my estate of real and personal property at my death.

I, Mary Williams, do hereby certify that my daughter Mary Elizabeth
 has received five shillings and that her share of the same shall
 be paid to her out of my estate after paying the legacies hereinafter
 directed. It is my will and desire that the residue of my estate which is not
 hereinafter disposed of by this my will shall be after the death or intestacy
 of my wife equally divided between my children viz William, Thomas
 John, George, Edmund, Elizabeth, Sarah, Thomas, David, Elizabeth, Peter
 Thomas, Robert, Edmund, John, Thomas, Sarah, Elizabeth, James, Thomas
 John, Edmund, James & Henry and Thompson. I desire and do
 understand that this my will and desire that none of the hereinafter
 directed or bequeathed legacies shall take effect until such time as
 the death of my wife Susan and William shall have taken place
 before my own decease. I desire and do understand that the share of each
 child shall be the rate of one sixteenth to be paid and given together
 with my own Thompson. I desire and do understand that the purpose of
 raising and educating three of my children viz an son of age
 It is my will and desire that my son John and Thomas should be my
 Executors and my sons David, Thomas and Peter Thomas should be my
 Executors to carry this my last will and Testament into effect. I desire
 my hand this 21st day of October 1810

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The Court of Quarterly Sessions held for Gloucestershire County on Monday the 26th

Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining Administration as the Law
directs along with the Will annexed in due form.
