in above amounting to two thousand one hundred & eighty five dollars  
and that the said Int<sup>r</sup> R Perkins has produced satisfactory vouchers  
showing the payment of sundry claims against the estate of the said  
Int<sup>r</sup> W Lewis amounting to the sum of two thousand nine hundred  
Eighty seven dollars & 26 cents having a balance not paid by the said  
Perkins of two dollars & 26 cents and we do hereby allow the said Perkins  
5 p. cent for collection and paying away the said sum of \$ 2785  
\$ 149.25 for commission given over in hands this 25 day of February  
1817

In the name of God Amen I Karym  
Inhabitant of the County of Fluvanna and State of Virginia being in  
my last state of health yet of sound mind and memory do make and  
hereby this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following  
After I have that all my just debts and funeral expences be paid  
I give, bequeath and bequeath unto my beloved Sister Mary Ann M. Blinson  
widow of Mark Blinson (with whom I now live) the sum of seven  
hundred and thirty six dollars together with the interest which may  
accrue to me for the purchase of a negro man named  
John Lewis and the same to be recorded in the books of the County Clerk

Item I give the sum of ~~one hundred~~ dollars and my  
think safe worth that Mary Ann McLean will be a good  
eighteen years old and then to be paid to her or to any person  
authorized to receive the same but at the same time will expect  
my executor or his Executor or Admin to apply the interest of said sum  
of money or as much as may be necessary to the use of said  
Mary Ann McLean as her necessities may require for her education at  
the discretion of my Executor herein after named - unless she shall  
marry before she arrives to that age then the said sum is to be  
paid to her or to any person authorized to receive it with  
whatever interest may be due and not appropriated to her and  
her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my Nephew Grandville Blinson son of the <sup>2d</sup> Mark  
(Blinson) my tract of Land lying in this <sup>2d</sup> County of Fluvanna adjoining  
the Lands of <sup>3d</sup> Mark Blinson and containing fifty acres be the same  
more or less to him and his heirs forever - www.virginiapioneer.net

Item I give unto my sister Christian Parrott all my bed clothes  
and wearing apparel which she has in her possession to her &  
her heirs forever -

Item I give and bequeath unto my sister Barbara Blinson one feather  
bed & furniture and all my bed covers together with my chid and all  
my wearing apparel which is now in my possession being with  
Mark Blinson her husband to her and her heirs forever

Item all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal  
including all debts due me & money on hand I give and bequeath  
unto Thomas Blinson son of <sup>2d</sup> Mark Blinson to him and his  
heirs forever Lastly I do constitute and appoint Mark Hunter  
Executor to this my last Will and Testament for making  
all former Wills or Wills by me made prior to this date void  
whereof I have however set my hand over the signature page  
of January 21st 1820 and done

At a Court of Quarterly Sessions held for Fluvanna County  
on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February 1870 This Will was this day  
read and proved by the executors of James T. Scott and John B. Mc-  
Lean the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and witness  
signed the executors thereto named to qualify thence and  
At a Court of Quarterly Sessions held for the said County in the  
<sup>27<sup>th</sup></sup> day of March 1870 On the wisdom of Walker Embelash the  
executor herein named who made oath before us the sum aforesaid  
and entered into and acknowledged here in the County of said County  
dolars with John Embelash Clerk of the County Court to the value of the  
sum directed certificate is granted him for obtaining a Deed
