also I give unto my ^{well} beloved Daughter Franky Lane and her
Negro girl named Ann (raising her life if she has a daughter then at
her death to go to and if not it is to return to William Lane and
Emily Rowe also I give all that which is my share to William Lane
and Emily Rowe and Franky Lane except my clothes they
are to be equally divided between all my daughters and daughters in
law. William Lane and Emily Rowe to have I likewise constitute
